Residency Continuity Clinic: PGY3's are at the Family Medicine Residency Clinic roughly 2 out of the 4 weeks during each block except during Inpatient Medicine Blocks and the Family Medicine Clinic Blocks. During the Inpatient Medicine Blocks, residents typically just have 2 days of Family Medicine Clinic.

Nursing Home: PGY2's and PGY3's are responsible for seeing their Continuity Patients on a Monthly basis at a Nursing Home near Broward Health Medical Center. PGY1's start seeing Continuity Patients on a Monthly basis during the second half of their PGY1 year.

NSU/Nursing Home On Call Resident: Each week, there is a Resident On Call for NSU/Nursing Home. That resident rounds on Tuesday at the Nursing Home with the Nursing Home Attending and answers any after hours or weekend emergency calls (from patients or for critical labs) for any of the NSU clinics, which is infrequent. The resident has half days of clinic during the week and also serves as backup for Family Medicine clinic or Inpatient Family Medicine Service in case a resident is sick and needs coverage. PGY1's serve as the on call resident towards the end of their PGY1 year.
